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Boil Water Notice Rescinded

September 2, 2025

RRA- Harrels Chapel Water System PWS 0960020

On August 26, 2025 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the Red River Authority of Texas RRA- Harrels Chapel Water System PWS 0960020, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of September 2, 2025.
